What is the timing?

We will leave Temple on Friday, April 3 at 12:30 p.m. and expect to return by late afternoon on Sunday, April 5. We will call from about an hour out from home.

Where is it and what are the accommodations?

We will be staying in an AirBnB home that has several rooms. Boys and girls will be housed in different rooms. Breakfast will be served in the house. Shabbat Dinner and Services on Friday will be with the students at the Drexel University Hillel Foundation, where one of our alumni is on staff. Ira Wise and Allie Burger will be driving vans (possibly a van and a car, depending on participation) to Philadelphia and around town.

How much will it cost?

The fee of \$250.00 per student includes van/car transportation from B'nai Israel to Philadelphia and back, breakfasts and dinners, lodging and the entire program. It is suggested that each student bring about \$30.00 for lunches on Saturday and Sunday.

What is the deadline for applications?

Applications and payment must be in the Education Center by Friday, March 20, 2020

Who do I talk to about financial assistance?

Call Ira Wise or Rabbi Marion at 203-336-1858 or e-mail Ira at iwise@cbibpt.org for any need-based aid. Funding should not be a reason for a student not to attend.

Who will be responsible for my son/daughter?

The staff for the weekend will include Ira Wise, Rabbi Marion, Rabbi Schultz, Allie Burger, our Young Israeli Emissaries, and/or a parent or members of the faculty. Staff members will be staying in the house with the students.

What do the students need to bring with them?

A packing list will be sent out on March 24.

What if there is an emergency and I need to reach my child?

What about medications?

Please let Ira know about ALL medications your child is bringing and taking in writing. If you feel your teen is able to be responsible for carrying and taking them at the appropriate time, great.
